## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the printing as a House document of a collection of memorial tributes made in honor of the late Gerald Solomon.

- 1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
- 2 *concurring),*

1 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZING PRINTING OF COLLECTION OF**  
2 **STATEMENTS IN TRIBUTE TO GERALD SOL-**  
3 **OMON.**

4 A collection of statements made in tribute to the late  
5 Gerald Solomon, together with related materials, shall be  
6 printed as a House document under the direction of the  
7 Joint Committee on Printing, with illustrations and suit-  
8 able binding.

9 **SEC. 2. NUMBER OF COPIES.**

10 The number of copies of the document printed under  
11 section 1 shall be the lesser of—

12 (1) 114 casebound copies, of which 50 copies  
13 shall be provided to the family of the late Gerald  
14 Solomon, 1 copy shall be provided to each Senator  
15 from the State of New York, and 2 copies shall be  
16 provided to each Member of the House of Represent-  
17 atives from the State of New York; or

18 (2) such number of casebound copies as does  
19 not exceed a total production and printing cost of

1       \$25,525, with distribution to be allocated in the  
2       same proportion as described in paragraph (1).
