6 **SEC. 2. RESPONSIBILITY OF CAPITOL POLICE BOARD.**

7 The Capitol Police Board shall take such actions as
8 may be necessary to carry out the event.

9 **SEC. 3. CONDITIONS RELATING TO PHYSICAL PREPARA-**
10 **TIONS.**

11 The Architect of the Capitol may prescribe conditions
12 for physical preparations for the event.

13 **SEC. 4. ENFORCEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS.**

14 The Capitol Police Board shall provide for enforce-
15 ment of the restrictions contained in section 4 of the Act
16 of July 31, 1946 (40 U.S.C. 193d; 60 Stat. 718), con-
17 cerning sales, advertisements, displays, and solicitations
18 on the Capitol Grounds, as well as other restrictions appli-
19 cable to the Capitol Grounds, in connection with the event.
