Mr. GOSS submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of
Representatives and conditional recess or adjournment
of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Wednesday, March 20, 2002, or Thursday,
4 March 21, 2002, on a motion offered pursuant to this con-
5 current resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee,
6 it stand adjourned until 2 p.m. on Tuesday, April 9, 2002,
7 or until Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to
8 section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
9 first; and that when the Senate recesses or adjourns at
10 the close of business on Thursday, March 21, 2002, Fri-

1 day, March 22, 2002, or Saturday, March 23, 2002, on
2 a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution
3 by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed
4 or adjourned until noon on Monday, April 8, 2002, or at
5 such other time on that day as may be specified in the
6 motion to recess or adjourn, or until Members are notified
7 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-
8 olution, whichever occurs first.

9 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
10 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
11 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
12 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
13 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble at such place
14 and time as they may designate whenever, in their opinion,
15 the public interest shall warrant it.
