## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for representation by Congress at a special meeting  
in New York, New York on Friday, September 6, 2002.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That: (a) The Speaker of the House of Rep-  
3 resentatives (in consultation with the Minority Leader of  
4 the House of Representatives), with respect to the House  
5 of Representatives, and the President pro tempore of the  
6 Senate (in consultation with the Majority Leader and the  
7 Minority Leader of the Senate), with respect to the Sen-  
8 ate, may send such Representatives, Senators and other  
9 appropriate persons, to a special meeting of Congress and  
10 related events to be held on Friday, September 6, 2002

1 in New York, New York, in remembrance of the terrorist  
2 attacks of September 11, 2001, and in recognition of the  
3 City of New York for the harm it sustained and its recov-  
4 ery.

5 (b) Attendees under subsection (a) shall be led by the  
6 Speaker and the Minority Leader of the House of Rep-  
7 resentatives, and by the President pro tempore (or his des-  
8 ignee), Majority Leader, and the Minority Leader of the  
9 Senate.

10 SEC. 2. The Congress may accept the offer of the City  
11 of New York and entities controlled by the City of New  
12 York to host and pay the expenses of the Congress to pre-  
13 pare, attend, and participate in the special meeting of Sep-  
14 tember 6, 2002, and related events of that day, referred  
15 to in section 1.

16 SEC. 3. On behalf of the Congress, the officers of the  
17 House of Representatives and the officers of the Senate  
18 may make arrangements with the City of New York and  
19 other required entities and agencies for participation by  
20 the Congress for the purposes designated under this reso-  
21 lution.
