CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Directing the Clerk of the House of Representatives to make technical corrections in the enrollment of the bill H.R. 1646.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That in the enrollment of the bill (H.R. 1646)
3 to authorize appropriations for the Department of State
4 for fiscal year 2003, to authorize appropriations under the
5 Arms Export Control Act and the Foreign Assistance Act

1 of 1961 for security assistance for fiscal year 2003, and
2 for other purposes, the Clerk of the House of Representa-
3 tives shall insert at the appropriate place the following new
4 section (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

5 **SEC. 1309. THREE-YEAR INTERNATIONAL ARMS CONTROL**
6 **AND NONPROLIFERATION STRATEGY.**

7 Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact-
8 ment of this Act, the Secretary of State shall prepare and
9 submit to the appropriate congressional committees a 3-
10 year international arms control and nonproliferation strat-
11 egy. The strategy shall contain the following:

12 (1) A 3-year plan for the reduction of existing
13 nuclear, chemical, and biological weapons and bal-
14 listic missiles and for controlling the proliferation of
15 these weapons.

16 (2) Identification of the goals and objectives of
17 the United States with respect to arms control and
18 nonproliferation of weapons of mass destruction and
19 their delivery systems.

20 (3) A description of the programs, projects, and
21 activities of the Department of State intended to ac-

1 accomplish goals and objectives described in paragraph
2 (2).
