CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the printing as a House document of a volume consisting of the transcripts of the ceremonial meeting of the House of Representatives and Senate in New York City on September 6, 2002, and a collection of statements by Members of the House of Representatives and Senate from the Congressional Record on the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001.

1 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZING PRINTING OF VOLUME OF TRAN-**
2 **SCRIPTS OF NEW YORK CITY MEETING AND**
3 **STATEMENTS ON TERRORIST ATTACKS OF**
4 **SEPTEMBER 11.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—A volume consisting of the tran-
6 scripts of the ceremonial meeting of the House of Rep-
7 resentatives and Senate in New York City on September
8 6, 2002, and a collection of statements by Members of
9 the House of Representatives and Senators on the ter-
10 rorist attacks of September 11, 2001, shall be printed as
11 a House document under the direction of the Joint Com-
12 mittee on Printing, with suitable binding.

13 (b) STATEMENTS TO BE INCLUDED IN VOLUME.—
14 A statement by a Member of the House of Representatives
15 or a Senator on the terrorist attacks of September 11,
16 2001, shall be included in the volume printed under sub-
17 section (a) if the statement—

18 (1) was printed in the Congressional Record
19 prior to the most recent date on which the House of
20 Representatives adjourned prior to the date of the
21 regularly scheduled general election in November
22 2002; and

23 (2) is approved for inclusion in the volume by
24 the Committee on House Administration of the
25 House of Representatives (in the case of a statement
26 by a Member of the House) or the Committee on

1 Rules and Administration of the Senate (in the case
2 of a statement by a Senator).

3 **SEC. 2. NUMBER OF COPIES.**

4 The number of copies of the document printed under
5 section 1 shall be 32,000 casebound copies, of which 50
6 copies shall be provided to each Member of the House of
7 Representatives and 100 copies shall be provided to each
8 Senator.

9 **SEC. 3. MEMBER DEFINED.**

10 In this concurrent resolution, the term “Member of
11 the House of Representatives” includes a Delegate or
12 Resident Commissioner to the Congress.
