CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the printing of a revised and updated version of the House document entitled “Women in Congress, 1917–1990”.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. PRINTING OF REVISED VERSION OF “WOMEN**
4 **IN CONGRESS, 1917–1990”.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—An updated version of House
6 Document 101–238, entitled “Women in Congress, 1917–
7 1990” (as revised by the Library of Congress), shall be
8 printed as a House document by the Public Printer, with
9 illustrations and suitable binding, under the direction of
10 the Committee on House Administration of the House of
11 Representatives.

12 (b) NUMBER OF COPIES.—In addition to the usual
13 number, there shall be printed 30,700 copies of the docu-
14 ment referred to in subsection (a), of which—

15 (1) 25,000 shall be for the use of the Com-
16 mittee on House Administration of the House of
17 Representatives; and

18 (2) 5,700 shall be for the use of the Committee
19 on Rules and Administration of the Senate.
