## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of  
Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment  
of the Senate.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3 tive day of Wednesday, April 4, 2001, or Thursday, April  
4 5, 2001, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent  
5 resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand  
6 adjourned until 2 p.m. on Tuesday, April 24, 2001, or  
7 until noon on the second day after Members are notified  
8 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-  
9 olution, whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate  
10 recesses or adjourns at the close of business on Friday,

1 April 6, 2001, Saturday, April 7, 2001, Sunday, April 8,  
2 2001, or Monday, April 9, 2001, on a motion offered pur-  
3 suant to this concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader  
4 or his designee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon  
5 on Monday, April 23, 2001, or until such time on that  
6 day as may be specified by its Majority Leader or his des-  
7 ignee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until noon  
8 on the second day after Members are notified to reassem-  
9 ble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,  
10 whichever occurs first.

11       SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
12 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with  
13 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-  
14 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House  
15 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in  
16 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
