Mr. GILMAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To authorize the American Friends of the Czech Republic to establish a memorial to honor Tomas G. Masaryk in the District of Columbia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH MEMORIAL.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The American Friends of the
5 Czech Republic is authorized to establish a memorial to
6 honor Tomas G. Masaryk on the Federal land in the Dis-
7 trict of Columbia described in subsection (b).

8 (b) LOCATION OF MEMORIAL.—The Federal land re-
9 ferred to in subsection (a) is the triangle of land in the
10 District of Columbia that is bordered by 19th Street, NW.,

1 H Street, NW., and Pennsylvania Avenue, NW., and des-
2 ignated as plot number 30 in area II on the map num-
3 bered 869/86501 and dated May 1, 1986, and which is
4 located across H Street, NW., from the International
5 Bank for Reconstruction and Development.

6 (c) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-
7 RATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the memorial shall
8 be in accordance with the Commemorative Works Act (40
9 U.S.C. 1001 et seq.).

10 (d) LIMITATION ON PAYMENT OF EXPENSES.—The
11 United States Government shall not pay any expense for
12 the establishment of the memorial.
