AN ACT

To authorize the Government of the Czech Republic to establish a memorial to honor Tomas G. Masaryk in the District of Columbia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH MEMORIAL.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Government of the Czech Re-
3 public is authorized to establish a memorial to honor
4 Tomas G. Masaryk on the Federal land in the District
5 of Columbia.

6 (b) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-
7 RATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the memorial shall
8 be in accordance with the Commemorative Works Act (40
9 U.S.C. 1001 et seq.), except that sections 2(c), 6(b), 8(b),
10 and 10(c) of that Act shall not apply with respect to the
11 memorial.

12 (c) LIMITATION ON PAYMENT OF EXPENSES.—The
13 United States Government shall not pay any expense for
14 the establishment of the memorial or its maintenance.
