## A BILL

To provide for the full funding of Federal Pell Grants.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Pell Grant Full Fund-  
5 ing Act of 2001”.

6 **SEC. 2. AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS FOR FULLY FUNDING FED-**  
7 **ERAL PELL GRANTS.**

8 (a) AMENDMENT.—Section 401 of the Higher Edu-  
9 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1070a) is amended by add-  
10 ing at the end the following new subsection:

11 “(k) AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.—Each fiscal year  
12 there shall be available to the Secretary, from funds not

1 otherwise appropriated, such amounts as may be nec-  
2 essary to pay to each student the amount for which such  
3 student is eligible under this section.”.

4 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section  
5 401(b)(3)(A) of such Act is amended by striking “for  
6 which an appropriation Act provides a maximum basic  
7 grant in an amount in excess of \$2,700”.
