## A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to eliminate the prohibitions on the transmission of abortion related matters, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Comstock Cleanup Act  
5 of 2001”.

6       **SEC. 2. IMPORTATION OR TRANSPORTATION OF CERTAIN**  
7                               **ABORTION-RELATED MATTERS.**

8       Section 1462 of title 18, United States Code, is  
9 amended—

1           (1) by striking “or” at the end of subparagraph  
2           (b) of the first undesignated paragraph; and  
3           (2) by striking subparagraph (c) of the first un-  
4           designated paragraph.

5 **SEC. 3. MAILING OF ABORTION-RELATED MATTERS.**

6           Section 1461 of title 18, United States Code, is  
7           amended by striking “; and” the first place it appears,  
8           and all that follows through “Is declared” and inserting  
9           “is declared”.
