A BILL

To amend the National Wildlife Refuge System Administration Act of 1966 to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to provide for maintenance and repair of buildings and properties located on lands in the National Wildlife Refuge System by lessees of such facilities, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LEASES, PERMITS, AND CONTRACTS FOR**
4 **BUILDINGS, FACILITIES, AND PROPERTIES IN**
5 **THE NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE SYSTEM.**

6 *(a) IN GENERAL.—The National Wildlife Refuge Sys-*
7 *tem Administration Act of 1966 (16 U.S.C. 668dd et seq.)*
8 *is amended by—*

9 *(1) striking section 6 (relating to amendments to*
10 *other laws, which have executed);*

11 *(2) redesignating section 5 (16 U.S.C. 668ee) as*
12 *section 6; and*

13 *(3) inserting after section 4 the following:*

14 **“SEC. 5. CONCESSION CONTRACTS.**

15 *“(a) CONTRACT REQUIREMENT.—(1) The Secretary*
16 *shall not award any concession that authorizes a person*
17 *to use any land or water in the System for any activity*
18 *described in subsection (b), except under a contract that*
19 *complies with the requirements established under subsection*
20 *(c).*

21 *“(2) The Secretary may not award a contract required*
22 *under this subsection except under a competitive bidding*
23 *process.*

24 *“(b) COVERED CONCESSION ACTIVITIES.—(1) The ac-*
25 *tivity referred to in subsection (a) is any activity conducted*

1 *to provide accommodations, facilities, or services to mem-*
2 *bers of the public who are visiting lands or waters in the*
3 *System, for the purpose of providing such visitors rec-*
4 *reational, educational, or interpretive enjoyment of lands*
5 *or waters in the System.*

6 “(2) *Such activity does not include—*

7 “(A) *any activity carried out under a procure-*
8 *ment contract, grant agreement, or cooperative agree-*
9 *ment required under chapter 63 of title 31, United*
10 *States Code;*

11 “(B) *the performance of volunteer services; and*

12 “(C) *any activity by a governmental entity.*

13 “(c) *STANDARDIZED CONTRACT.—(1) The Secretary,*
14 *acting through the Director, shall issue regulations that es-*
15 *tablish a standardized contract for purposes of subsection*
16 *(a).*

17 “(2) *Regulations under this subsection shall authorize*
18 *a contract to use a provision other than those specified by*
19 *the regulations only if—*

20 “(A) *the provision addresses extenuating cir-*
21 *cumstances that are specific to a refuge or the con-*
22 *tract; and*

23 “(B) *the provision is approved by the Director*
24 *in writing.*

1 “(3) Regulations under this subsection shall require in
2 each contract provisions that require that any activity con-
3 ducted in the System under the contract—

4 “(A) must be a compatible use; and

5 “(B) must be designed to—

6 “(i) conserve the natural and cultural re-
7 sources of the System;

8 “(ii) facilitate the enjoyment of the lands
9 and waters of the System by visitors to the Sys-
10 tem; and

11 “(iii) enhance the such visitors’ knowledge
12 of the natural resources of the System.

13 “(d) MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR.—(1) Notwith-
14 standing any other provision of law, the Secretary shall in-
15 clude, in each contract that authorizes a person to use any
16 land or water in the System for any activity described in
17 subsection (b), provisions that—

18 “(A) authorize the person to maintain or repair
19 any improvement on or in such land or water that
20 the person is authorized to use for such activity; and

21 “(B) treat costs incurred by the person for such
22 maintenance or repair as consideration otherwise re-
23 quired to be paid to the United States for such use.

24 “(2) This subsection does not authorize any mainte-
25 nance or repair that is not directly related to an activity

1 *described in subsection (b) that is authorized by the con-*
2 *tract.*

3 “(3) *The United States shall retain title to all property*
4 *that is maintained or repaired under this subsection.*

5 “(e) *NO COMPENSABLE INTEREST.—Nothing in this*
6 *Act shall be considered to convey to any person any right*
7 *to compensation for—*

8 “(1) *the value of any maintenance activities, re-*
9 *pairs, construction, or improvements on or in land or*
10 *water in the System; or*

11 “(2) *buildings, facilities, fixtures, and non-mov-*
12 *able equipment that the person is authorized to use*
13 *under this Act.*

14 “(f) *EXPENDITURE OF FEES AND OTHER PAY-*
15 *MENTS.—(1) Amounts received by the United States as fees*
16 *or other payments required under any agreement, lease,*
17 *permit, or contract for use of real property located in an*
18 *area in the System shall be available to the Secretary for*
19 *expenditure in accordance with this subsection, without fur-*
20 *ther appropriation.*

21 “(2) *Amounts available for expenditure under this sub-*
22 *section may only be used—*

23 “(A) *at the refuge or refuge complex with respect*
24 *to which the amounts were received as fees or other*
25 *payments;*

1 “(B) to increase the quality of the visitor experi-
2 ence; and

3 “(C) for purposes of—

4 “(i) backlogged repair and maintenance
5 projects (including projects relating to health
6 and safety);

7 “(ii) interpretation, signage, habitat, or fa-
8 cility enhancement;

9 “(iii) resource preservation; or

10 “(iv) administration of agreements, leases,
11 permits, and contracts from which such amounts
12 are derived.

13 “(3) Paragraph (1) shall not affect the application of
14 the Act of June 15, 1935 (chapter 261; 16 U.S.C. 715s),
15 commonly referred to as the Refuge Revenue Sharing Act,
16 to amounts referred to in paragraph (1) that are not ex-
17 pended by the Secretary under paragraph (1).”.

18 (b) APPLICATION.—Section 5(a) of the National Wild-
19 life Refuge System Administration Act of 1966, as amended
20 by this section, shall apply only with respect to a concession
21 that is—

22 (1) first awarded after the date of the publica-
23 tion of regulations under section 5(c) of the National
24 Wildlife Refuge System Administration Act of 1966,
25 as amended by this section; or

1 (2) renewed after the end of the 3-year period be-
2 ginning on the date of the enactment of this Act.

3 (c) *DEADLINE FOR REGULATIONS ESTABLISHING*
4 *STANDARDIZED CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS.*—The Sec-
5 retary of the Interior shall issue regulations under section
6 5(c) of the National Wildlife Refuge System Administration
7 Act of 1966, as amended by this section, by not later than
8 18 months after the date of the enactment of this Act.

9 (d) *COMPREHENSIVE CONSERVATION PLAN REQUIRE-*
10 *MENT.*—Section 4(e) of the National Wildlife Refuge System
11 Administration Act of 1966 (16 U.S.C. 668dd) is amended
12 by adding at the end the following:

13 “(5) The Secretary shall include, in the comprehensive
14 conservation plan for each refuge under this subsection, a
15 description of the activities that may be conducted in the
16 refuge, and the lands, waters, and facilities of the refuge
17 that may be used, under concession contracts awarded
18 under section 5(a).”.

19 (e) *PRIOR AMENDMENTS NOT AFFECTED.*—Nothing in
20 this section shall be construed to affect any amendment
21 made by section 6 of the National Wildlife Refuge System
22 Administration Act of 1966, as in effect before the enact-
23 ment of this Act, or any provision of law amended by such
24 section.

1 (f) *ANNUAL REPORT ON NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE*
2 *CONCESSIONS.*—

3 (1) *REPORTING REQUIREMENT.*—*The National*
4 *Wildlife Refuge System Administration Act of 1966*
5 *(16 U.S.C. 668dd et seq.) is further amended by add-*
6 *ing at the end the following:*

7 **“SEC. 7. ANNUAL REPORT ON CONCESSION ACTIVITIES IN**
8 **THE SYSTEM.**

9 “(a) *IN GENERAL.*—*The Secretary shall submit by De-*
10 *cember 31 each year, to the Committee on Resources of the*
11 *House of Representatives and the Committee on Environ-*
12 *ment and Public Works of the Senate, a report on conces-*
13 *sions activities conducted in the System.*

14 “(b) *CONTENTS.*—*Each report under this section shall*
15 *describe the following with respect to the period covered by*
16 *the report:*

17 “(1) *The number of refuge units in which conces-*
18 *sions activities were conducted.*

19 “(2) *The names and descriptions of services of-*
20 *fered in the System by each concessionaire.*

21 “(3) *A listing of the different types of legal ar-*
22 *rangements under which concessionaires operated in*
23 *the System, including contracts, memoranda of un-*
24 *derstanding, permits, letters of agreement, and other*
25 *arrangements.*

1 “(4) Amounts of fees or other payments received
2 by the United States with respect to such activities
3 from each concessionaire, and the portion of such
4 funds expended for purposes under this Act.

5 “(5) An accounting of the amount of monies de-
6 posited into the fund established by section 401 of the
7 Act of June 15, 1935 (chapter 261; 16 U.S.C. 715s),
8 popularly known as the refuge revenue sharing fund,
9 and of the balance remaining in the fund at the end
10 of the reporting period.

11 “(6) A listing of all concession contracts and
12 other arrangements that were terminated or not re-
13 newed within the reporting period.

14 “(7) A summary of all improvements in visitor
15 services in the System that were completed by conces-
16 sionaires and volunteers during the reporting period.

17 “(8) A summary of all backlogged repair and
18 maintenance, facility enhancement, and resource pres-
19 ervation projects completed by concessionaires and
20 volunteers during the reporting period.”.

21 (2) *DEADLINE FOR FIRST REPORT.*—The Sec-
22 retary of the Interior shall submit the first report
23 under the amendment made by paragraph (1) by not
24 later than 1 year after the date of the enactment of
25 this Act.

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to amend the National Wildlife Refuge System Administration Act of 1966 to establish requirements for the award of concessions in the National Wildlife Refuge System, to provide for maintenance and repair of properties located in the System by concessionaires authorized to use such properties, and for other purposes.”.
