7 Treatment Act is amended by striking “, \$66,000,000 for
8 fiscal year 1997” and all that follows and inserting

1 “\$66,000,000 for fiscal year 2002, \$76,000,000 for fiscal
2 year 2003, \$86,000,000 for fiscal year 2004, \$96,000,000
3 for fiscal year 2005, and \$106,000,000 for fiscal year
4 2006.”.
