## A BILL

To extend for 4 additional months the period for which chapter 12 of title 11 of the United States Code is reenacted.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS.**

4       Section 149 of title I of division C of Public Law  
5       105–277, as amended by Public Law 106–5, Public Law  
6       106–70, and Public Law 107–8, is amended—

7               (1) by striking “June 1, 2001” each place it  
8       appears and inserting “October 1, 2001”, and

9               (2) in subsection (a)—

1 (A) by striking “June 30, 2000” and in-  
2 sserting “May 31, 2001”, and

3 (B) by striking “July 1, 2000” and insert-  
4 ing “June 1, 2001”.

5 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

6 The amendments made by section 1 shall take effect  
7 on June 1, 2001.
