3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

4 The Raystown Lake located on the Raystown Branch
5 of the Juniata River in Pennsylvania shall be known and
6 redesignated as the “Bud Shuster Lake”.

7 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

8 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
9 paper, or other record of the United States to the lake

1 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
2 to the “Bud Shuster Lake”.
