A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to expand the list of diseases presumed to be service connected in the case of radiation-exposed veterans and to expand the circumstances deemed have been radiation-risk activities for members of the Armed Forces.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Justice for Atomic Vet-
5 erans Act of 2001”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF LIST OF DISEASES PRESUMED TO**
 2 **BE SERVICE CONNECTED FOR RADIATION-EX-**
 3 **POSED VETERANS.**

4 Section 1112(c)(2) of title 38, United States Code,
 5 is amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
 6 paragraphs:

7 “(Q) Lung cancer.

8 “(R) Bone cancer.

9 “(S) Skin cancer.

10 “(T) Colon cancer.

11 “(U) Posterior subcapsular cataracts.

12 “(V) Nonmalignant thyroid nodular disease.

13 “(W) Ovarian cancer.

14 “(X) Parathyroid adenoma.

15 “(Y) Tumors of the brain and central nervous
 16 system.

17 “(Z) Rectal cancer.”.

18 **SEC. 3. EXPANSION OF SERVICE CIRCUMSTANCES DEEMED**
 19 **TO BE RADIATION-RISK ACTIVITIES.**

20 Section 1112(c)(3)(B) of title 38, United States
 21 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new
 22 clauses:

23 “(iv) Service at Amchitka Island, Alaska,
 24 involving the performance of duty related to the
 25 Long Shot, Milrow or Cannikin underground
 26 nuclear tests which were conducted on that is-

1 land during the period beginning October 23,
2 1965, and ending December 31, 1973.

3 “(v) Service at such other locations, during
4 such periods of time, as the Secretary deter-
5 mines by regulation to be service that is com-
6 parable as a radiation-risk activity to the serv-
7 ice specified in clauses (i) through (iv).”.
