A BILL

To reauthorize various fishery conservation management
programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Fisheries Conservation*
5 *Act of 2001”.*

1 **TITLE I—INTERJURISDICTIONAL**
2 **FISHERIES ACT OF 1986**

3 **SEC. 101. REAUTHORIZATION OF INTERJURISDICTIONAL**
4 **FISHERIES ACT OF 1986.**

5 *Section 308 of the Interjurisdictional Fisheries Act of*
6 *1986 (16 U.S.C. 4107) is amended—*

7 *(1) by amending subsection (a) to read as fol-*
8 *lows:*

9 *“(a) GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS.—There are author-*
10 *ized to be appropriated to the Department of Commerce for*
11 *apportionment to carry out the purposes of this title—*

12 *“(1) \$4,900,000 for fiscal year 2002;*

13 *“(2) \$5,400,000 for each of fiscal years 2003 and*
14 *2004; and*

15 *“(3) \$5,900,000 for each of fiscal years 2005 and*
16 *2006.”; and*

17 *(2) in subsection (c) by striking “\$700,000 for*
18 *fiscal year 1997, and \$750,000 for each of the fiscal*
19 *years 1998, 1999, and 2000” and inserting “\$800,000*
20 *for fiscal year 2002, \$850,000 for each of fiscal years*
21 *2003 and 2004, and \$900,000 for each of fiscal years*
22 *2005 and 2006”.*

1 **SEC. 102. PURPOSES OF THE INTERJURISDICTIONAL FISH-**
2 **ERIES ACT OF 1986**

3 *Section 302 of the Interjurisdictional Fisheries Act of*
4 *1986 (16 U.S.C. 4101) is amended by striking “and” after*
5 *the semicolon at the end of paragraph (1), striking the pe-*
6 *riod at the end of paragraph (2) and inserting “; and”,*
7 *and adding at the end the following:*

8 *“(3) to promote and encourage research in prep-*
9 *aration for the implementation of the use of eco-*
10 *systems and interspecies approaches to the conserva-*
11 *tion and management of interjurisdictional fishery*
12 *resources throughout their range.”.*

13 **TITLE II—ANADROMOUS FISH**
14 **CONSERVATION ACT**

15 **SEC. 201. REAUTHORIZATION OF ANADROMOUS FISH CON-**
16 **SERVATION ACT.**

17 *Section 4 of the Anadromous Fish Conservation Act*
18 *(16 U.S.C. 757d) is amended to read as follows:*

19 **“AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS**

20 **“SEC. 4. (a)(1) There are authorized to be appro-**
21 **priated to carry out the purposes of this Act not to exceed**
22 **the following sums:**

23 **“(A) \$4,500,000 for fiscal year 2002;**

24 **“(B) \$4,750,000 for each of fiscal years 2003 and**
25 **2004; and**

2 **FISHERIES**

3 **SEC. 301. REAUTHORIZATION OF ATLANTIC STRIPED BASS**
4 **CONSERVATION ACT.**

5 *Section 7(a) of the Atlantic Striped Bass Conservation*
6 *Act (16 U.S.C. 1851 note) is amended by striking “and*
7 *2003” and inserting “2003, 2004, 2005, and 2006”.*

8 **SEC. 302. REAUTHORIZATION OF ATLANTIC COASTAL FISHERIES**
9 **COOPERATIVE MANAGEMENT ACT.**

10 *Section 811(a) of the Atlantic Coastal Fisheries Coop-*
11 *erative Management Act (16 U.S.C. 5108) is amended by*
12 *striking “2005” and inserting “2006”.*

13 **SEC. 303. AMENDMENTS TO ATLANTIC COASTAL FISHERIES**
14 **COOPERATIVE MANAGEMENT ACT.**

15 *(a) FINDINGS.—Section 802(a) of the Atlantic Coastal*
16 *Fisheries Cooperative Management Act (16 U.S.C. 5101(a))*
17 *is amended by adding at the end the following:*

18 *“(7) The understanding of the interactions of*
19 *species in the maritime environment and the develop-*
20 *ment of ecosystems-based approaches to fishery con-*
21 *servation and management lead to better stewardship*
22 *and sustainability of coastal fishery resources.*

23 *“(8) Federal and State scientists should gather*
24 *information on the interaction of species in the ma-*

1 *rine environment and provide this scientific informa-*
2 *tion to Federal and State managers.”.*

3 *(b) PURPOSE.—Section 802(b) of such Act (16 U.S.C.*
4 *5101(b)) is amended to read as follows:*

5 *“(b) PURPOSE.—The purpose of this title is to support*
6 *and encourage the development, implementation, and en-*
7 *forcement of effective interstate conservation and manage-*
8 *ment of Atlantic coastal fishery resources through the use*
9 *of sound science and multispecies, adaptive, and ecosystem-*
10 *based management measures.”.*

11 *(c) STATE-FEDERAL COOPERATION IN MULTISPECIES*
12 *AND ECOSYSTEMS INTERACTION RESEARCH.—Section*
13 *804(a) of such Act (16 U.S.C. 5103(a)) is amended by in-*
14 *serting “multispecies and ecosystems interaction research;”*
15 *after “biological and socioeconomic research;”.*

16 *(d) ASSISTANCE FOR RESEARCH REGARDING INTER-*
17 *RELATIONSHIPS AMONG ATLANTIC COASTAL FISHERY RE-*
18 *SOURCES AND THEIR ECOSYSTEMS.—Section 808 of such*
19 *Act (16 U.S.C. 5107) is amended by striking “and” after*
20 *the semicolon at the end of paragraph (1), redesignating*
21 *paragraph (2) as paragraph (3), and inserting after para-*
22 *graph (1) the following:*

23 *“(2) research to understand the interrelation-*
24 *ships among Atlantic coastal fishery resources and*
25 *their ecosystems; and”.*

1 **TITLE IV—NOAA MARINE FISH**
2 **INFORMATION AND ANALYSIS**
3 **ACTIVITIES**

4 **SEC. 401. REAUTHORIZATION OF NOAA MARINE FISH PRO-**
5 **GRAM.**

6 (a) *FISHERIES INFORMATION COLLECTION AND ANAL-*
7 *YSIS.*—*There are authorized to be appropriated to the Sec-*
8 *retary of Commerce, to enable the National Oceanic and*
9 *Atmospheric Administration to carry out fisheries informa-*
10 *tion and analysis activities under the Fish and Wildlife Act*
11 *of 1956 (16 U.S.C. 742a et seq.) and any other law involv-*
12 *ing those activities, \$72,248,000 for fiscal year 2002,*
13 *\$76,640,000 for each of fiscal years 2003 and 2004, and*
14 *\$82,893,000 for each of fiscal years 2005 and 2006. Such*
15 *activities may include, but are not limited to, the collection,*
16 *analysis, and dissemination of scientific information nec-*
17 *essary for the management of living marine resources and*
18 *associated marine habitat.*

19 (b) *FISHERIES CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT OP-*
20 *ERATIONS.*—*There are authorized to be appropriated to the*
21 *Secretary of Commerce, to enable the National Oceanic and*
22 *Atmospheric Administration to carry out activities relating*
23 *to fisheries conservation and management operations under*
24 *the Fish and Wildlife Act of 1956 (16 U.S.C. 742a et seq.)*
25 *and any other law involving those activities, \$122,105,000*

1 *for fiscal year 2002, \$125,529,000 for each of fiscal years*
2 *2003 and 2004, and \$135,856,000 for each of fiscal years*
3 *2005 and 2006. Such activities may include, but are not*
4 *limited to, development, implementation, and enforcement*
5 *of conservation and management measures to achieve con-*
6 *tinued optimum use of living marine resources, hatchery*
7 *operations, habitat conservation, and protected species*
8 *management.*

9 (c) *FISHERIES STATE AND INDUSTRY COOPERATIVE*
10 *PROGRAMS.—There are authorized to be appropriated to*
11 *the Secretary of Commerce, to enable the National Oceanic*
12 *and Atmospheric Administration to carry out State and in-*
13 *dustry cooperative programs under the Fish and Wildlife*
14 *Act of 1956 (16 U.S.C. 742a et seq.) and any other law*
15 *involving those activities, \$28,520,000 for fiscal year 2002,*
16 *\$28,814,000 for each of fiscal years 2003 and 2004, and*
17 *\$29,967,000 for each of fiscal years 2005 and 2006. These*
18 *activities include, but are not limited to, ensuring the qual-*
19 *ity and safety of seafood products and providing grants to*
20 *States for improving the management of interstate fisheries.*

21 (d) *RELATION TO OTHER LAWS.—Authorizations*
22 *under this section shall be in addition to monies authorized*
23 *under the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and*
24 *Management Act of 1976 (16 U.S.C. 1801 et seq.), the Ma-*
25 *rine Mammal Protection Act of 1972 (16 U.S.C. 1361 et*

1 *seq.*), the *Endangered Species Act of 1973* (16 U.S.C. 3301
2 *et seq.*), the *Anadromous Fish Conservation Act* (16 U.S.C.
3 757 *et seq.*), and the *Interjurisdictional Fisheries Act* (16
4 U.S.C. 4107 *et seq.*).

5 **TITLE V—ATLANTIC TUNAS**
6 **CONVENTION ACT OF 1975**

7 **SEC. 501. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE ATLANTIC TUNAS**
8 **CONVENTION ACT OF 1975.**

9 *Section 10 of the Atlantic Tunas Convention Act of*
10 *1975 (16 U.S.C. 971h) is amended to read as follows:*

11 *“AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS*

12 *“SEC. 10. (a) IN GENERAL.—There are authorized to*
13 *be appropriated to carry out this Act, including use for*
14 *payment of the United States share of the joint expenses*
15 *of the Commission as provided in Article X of the Conven-*
16 *tion, the following sums:*

17 *“(1) For each of fiscal years 2002, 2003, and*
18 *2004, \$5,480,000.*

19 *“(2) For each of fiscal years 2005 and 2006,*
20 *\$5,495,000.*

21 *“(b) ALLOCATION.—Of amounts available under this*
22 *section for each fiscal year—*

23 *“(1) \$150,000 are authorized for the advisory*
24 *committee established under section 4 and the species*
25 *working groups established under section 4A; and*

1 “(2) \$4,240,000 are authorized for research ac-
2 tivities under this Act and the Act of September 4,
3 1980 (16 U.S.C. 971i).”.

4 **TITLE VI—NORTHWEST ATLAN-**
5 **TIC FISHERIES CONVENTION**
6 **ACT OF 1995**

7 **SEC. 601. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE NORTHWEST ATLAN-**
8 **TIC FISHERIES CONVENTION ACT OF 1995.**

9 Section 211 of the Northwest Atlantic Fisheries Con-
10 vention Act of 1995 (16 U.S.C. 5610) is amended by strik-
11 ing “2001” and inserting “2006”.
