3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as “Suzanne’s Law”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT.**

2 Section 3701(a) of the Crime Control Act of 1990
3 (42 U.S.C. 5779(a)) is amended by striking “age of 18”
4 and inserting “age of 21”.
