A BILL

To prohibit issuance of a visa, or admission to the United States, of any physician who is a citizen of the People's Republic of China and who seeks to enter for the purpose of training in organ or bodily tissue transplantation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Secretary
4 of State shall not issue an immigrant or nonimmigrant
5 visa to, and the Attorney General shall not admit to the
6 United States, any physician (as such term is used in Im-
7 migration and Nationality Act) who is a citizen of the Peo-

1 ple's Republic of China who seeks the visa or admission
2 to the United States for the purpose of training in organ
3 or bodily tissue transplantation.
