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# A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONNECTICUT RIVER ATLANTIC SALMON COM-**  
4 **PACT.**

5 (a) *EFFECTIVE PERIOD OF CONGRESSIONAL CON-*  
6 *SENT.—Section 3(2) of Public Law 98–138 (97 Stat. 870)*  
7 *is amended by striking “twenty years” and inserting “40*  
8 *years”.*

9 (b) *AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Public*  
10 *Law 98–138 (97 Stat. 866) is amended by adding at the*  
11 *end the following:*

12 **“SEC. 6. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

13 *“There is authorized to be appropriated to the Sec-*  
14 *retary of the Interior to carry out the activities of the Con-*  
15 *necticut River Atlantic Salmon Commission \$5,000,000 for*  
16 *each of fiscal years 2002 through 2010.”.*
