Mrs. CAPPS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Rodney E. Hoover.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. IN GENERAL.**

4 The United States District Court for the Eastern
5 District of California shall have jurisdiction to hear, deter-
6 mine, and render judgment on any claim of or on behalf
7 of Rodney E. Hoover of Arroyo Grande, California,
8 against the United States for personal injuries which he
9 allegedly sustained in an accident on February 26, 1940,
10 and in transport on March 4, 1940, while a member of
11 the Civilian Conservation Corps in Beaver City, Nebraska.

1 **SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER PROVISIONS.**

2 Solely for the purposes of establishing jurisdiction
3 under section 1346(b) of title 28, United States Code, the
4 events giving rise to the alleged injuries referred to in sec-
5 tion 1 shall be deemed to have occurred after January 1,
6 1945.

7 **SEC. 3. TIME LIMITATION.**

8 Any claim under this Act shall be barred unless it
9 is filed with the appropriate Federal agency pursuant to
10 section 2675 of title 28, United States Code, within six
11 months after the date of enactment of this Act, and such
12 claim, if so filed, shall be considered to have been filed
13 in a timely manner notwithstanding the time limitation of
14 section 2401 of such title.

15 **SEC. 4. LIABILITY.**

16 Nothing in this Act shall be construed as an inter-
17 ference or admission of liability by the United States.
