A BILL

1 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS TO THE CENTRAL UTAH**
2 **PROJECT COMPLETION ACT.**

3 (a) CLARIFICATION OF SECRETARIAL RESPONSIBIL-
4 ITIES.—Section 201(e) of the Central Utah Project Com-
5 pletion Act (106 Stat. 4608) is amended—

6 (1) by striking “identified in this Act,” and in-
7 sserting “identified in this title and the Act of April
8 11, 1956 (Chapter 203; 70 Stat. 110 et seq.), popu-
9 larly known as the Colorado River Storage Project
10 Act, relating to the Central Utah Project including
11 oversight for all phases of the Central Utah Project,
12 the administration of all prior and future contracts,
13 and operation and maintenance of previously con-
14 structed facilities,”; and

15 (2) by striking “his responsibilities under this
16 Act” and inserting “such responsibilities”.

17 (b) USE OF UNEXPENDED BUDGET AUTHORITY.—
18 Section 202(c) of the Central Utah Project Completion
19 Act (106 Stat. 4611) is amended in the first sentence—

20 (1) by striking “in this title up to \$60,000,000”
21 and inserting “for units of the Central Utah
22 Project”; and

23 (2) by inserting “including use of reverse osmo-
24 sis membrane technologies, water recycling, and con-
25 junctive use” after “conservation measures”.

1 (c) PREPAYMENT OF REPAYMENT.—Section 210 of
2 the Central Utah Project Completion Act (106 Stat. 4624)
3 is amended—

4 (1) in the second sentence—

5 (A) by inserting “or any additional or sup-
6 plemental repayment contract” after “1985,”;
7 and

8 (B) by inserting “of the Central Utah
9 Project” after “water delivery facilities”; and

10 (2) by striking “The District shall exercise”
11 and all that follows through the end of that sen-
12 tence.
