2 **“§ 1601. Enticement**

3 “(a) Whoever, having attained the age of 18 years,
4 through the mails or any instrumentality of communica-
5 tion that is in or affects interstate or foreign commerce,
6 intentionally entices a child to run away from home and
7 thereby interferes with the parental rights of another per-
8 son, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more
9 than 5 years, or both.

10 “(b) As used in this section, the term ‘child’ means
11 a person who has not attained the age of 18 years.”.

12 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of chapters
13 at the beginning of part I of title 18, United States Code,
14 is amended by inserting after the item relating to chapter
15 77 the following new item:

“78. Parental Rights Protection 1601”.
