6 1320d–2(f)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
7 lowing: “For purposes of this subsection, the term ‘coordi-
8 nation of benefits’ means provisions that meet the stand-

1 ards and requirements of the 1996 NAIC Group Coordina-
2 tion of Benefits Model Regulation.”.
