3 **SECTION 1. NORMAN SISISKY POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 3131 South Crater Road in Pe-

1 tersburg, Virginia, shall be known and designated as the
2 “Norman Sisisky Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the Norman Sisisky Post
7 Office Building.
