A BILL

To provide authority to the Federal Power Marketing Administrations to reduce vandalism and destruction of property, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROPERTY PROTECTION PROGRAM FOR**
4 **POWER MARKETING ADMINISTRATIONS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrators of the West-
6 ern Area Power Administration Administrator, the South-
7 western Power Administration, and the Southeastern
8 Power Administration may each carry out programs to re-
9 duce vandalism and destruction of property that is under
10 their jurisdiction.

1 (b) PROVISION OF REWARDS.—In carrying out a pro-
2 gram under this section, each Administrator referred to
3 in subsection (a) is authorized to provide rewards (includ-
4 ing cash rewards) to individuals who provide information
5 or evidence leading to the arrest and prosecution of indi-
6 viduals causing damage to Federal property under their
7 jurisdiction. The amount of any one such reward paid to
8 any individual may not exceed a value of \$1,000.
