## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Transportation to conduct an assessment of terrorist-related threats to all forms of public transportation.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Terrorism Threat to  
5       Public Transportation Assessment Act of 2001”.

6       **SEC. 2. TERRORIST-RELATED THREATS TO PUBLIC TRANS-**  
7       **PORTATION.**

8       (a) ASSESSMENT.—The Secretary of Transportation,  
9       in consultation with the heads of other appropriate Fed-  
10       eral departments and agencies, shall conduct an assess-

1 ment of terrorist-related threats to all forms of public  
2 transportation, including public gathering areas related to  
3 public transportation.

4 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 30 days after the date  
5 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall transmit to  
6 the President and Congress a report on the results of the  
7 assessment conducted under this section, including the  
8 Secretary’s recommendations for legislative and adminis-  
9 trative actions.
