A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. INCREASE IN MAXIMUM LUMP-SUM DEATH**
2 **BENEFIT AND ELIGIBILITY OF LEGAL REP-**
3 **RESENTATIVE OF ESTATE.**

4 Section 202(i) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
5 402(i)) is amended—

6 (1) by striking “\$255” and inserting “\$1,000”;

7 (2) in paragraph (1), by striking “or” at the
8 end;

9 (3) in paragraph (2), by striking “death.” and
10 inserting “death; or”; and

11 (4) by inserting after paragraph (2) the fol-
12 lowing new paragraph:

13 “(3) if there is no person who qualifies for pay-
14 ment under paragraph (1) or (2), or if such person
15 dies before receiving payment, to the legal represent-
16 ative of the estate of the deceased individual, if
17 any.”.

18 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

19 The amendments made by this Act shall apply with
20 respect to deaths occurring on or after the date of the
21 enactment of this Act.
