## A BILL

To provide for a study on the feasibility of giving airlines access by computer to lists of suspected terrorists.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Airline Check for Ter-  
5 rorist Act (ACT)”.

6 **SEC. 2. STUDY OF ACCESS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than December 31,  
8 2002, the Federal Bureau of Investigation shall study and  
9 report to Congress on the feasibility of providing to air-

1 lines access via computer to the names of passengers who  
2 are suspected of terrorist activity by Federal officials.

3 (b) AUTHORIZATION.—There are authorized to be ap-  
4 propriated for fiscal years 2002 through 2003 not more  
5 than \$250,000 to carry out subsection (a).
