A BILL

For the relief of Mrs. Marie Marlow of Friendswood, Texas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall pay to Mrs.

4 Marie Marlow of Friendswood, Texas, a sum equal to—

5 (1) the difference between the amount of vet-

6 erans' disability benefits that her late father, Albert

7 A. Mokal, received, and the amount that he would

8 have received had the correct special monthly com-

9 pensation rate been applied from May 12, 1946,

10 through March 24, 1980; and

11 (2) the amount of interest that the Secretary

12 calculates would have accrued on such additional

1 amounts from March 24, 1980, to the date payment
2 is made pursuant to this act, if such additional
3 amounts had been paid correctly on March 24,
4 1980.
