3 (b) SUBJECTS.—The study shall include examination
4 and identification of the following:

5 (1) The number of children who were killed or
6 are missing in connection with such attacks.

7 (2) The number of children having a parent or
8 legal guardian who was killed or is missing in con-
9 nection with such attacks.

10 (3) For each of the children and each parent
11 referred to in paragraphs (1) and (2), respectively,
12 the parent or child’s—

13 (A) identity;

14 (B) residence; and

15 (C) citizenship and immigration status.

16 (4) Such other matters as the Comptroller Gen-
17 eral considers appropriate.

18 (c) REPORT.—The Comptroller General shall submit
19 to the Congress a report on the findings and conclusions
20 of the study under this section by not later than 90 days
21 after the date of the enactment of this Act.

22 (d) CHILDREN AND CHILD DEFINED.—In this sec-
23 tion the terms “child” and “children” do not include any
24 individual 18 years of age or older.
