## A BILL

To amend the Emergency Food Assistance Act of 1983 to permit States to use administrative funds to pay costs relating to the processing, transporting, and distributing to eligible recipient agencies of donated wild game.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Hunters Help the  
5 Hungry Act of 2001”.

1 **SEC. 2. USE OF ADMINISTRATIVE FUNDS FOR DONATED**  
2 **WILD GAME.**

3 Section 204(a)(1) of the Emergency Food Assistance  
4 Act of 1983 (7 U.S.C. 7508(a)(1)) is amended in the first  
5 sentence—

6 (1) by striking “\$50,000,000” and inserting  
7 “\$70,000,000”; and

8 (2) by inserting before the period at the end the  
9 following: “(including donated wild game, using not  
10 more than a percentage established by the Secretary  
11 (by regulation) of funds appropriated for a fiscal  
12 year)”.
