4 **TRACT OF NANTAHALA NATIONAL FOREST,**
5 **JACKSON COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA, IN**
6 **HONOR OF JAMES AND ELSPETH MCCLURE**
7 **CLARKE.**

8 The portion of the Nantahala National Forest in
9 Jackson County, North Carolina, known as the
10 Pantherstown Valley tract and consisting of approximately

1 6,294 acres is hereby designated as the “James and
2 Elspeth McClure Clarke Forest” in honor of James and
3 Elspeth McClure Clarke.
