AN ACT

To revise the boundary of the Glen Canyon National
Recreation Area in the States of Utah and Arizona.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Glen Canyon National
5 Recreation Area Boundary Revision Act of 2002”.

6 **SEC. 2. GLEN CANYON NATIONAL RECREATION AREA**
7 **BOUNDARY REVISION.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The first section of Public Law
9 92–593 (16 U.S.C. 460dd; 86 Stat. 1311) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “That in” and inserting “SEC-
2 TION 1. (a) In”; and

3 (2) by adding at the end the following:

4 ~~“(b)(1)~~ *“(b)* In addition to the boundary change au-
5 thority under subsection (a), the Secretary may acquire
6 approximately 152 acres of private land in exchange for
7 approximately 370 acres of land within the boundary of
8 Glen Canyon National Recreation Area, as generally de-
9 picted on the map entitled ‘Page One Land Exchange Pro-
10 posal’, number 608/60573a–2002, and dated May 16,
11 2002. The map shall be on file and available for public
12 inspection in the appropriate offices of the National Park
13 Service. Upon conclusion of the exchange, the boundary
14 of the recreation area shall be revised to reflect the ex-
15 change.

16 ~~“(2) Before the land exchange under this subsection,~~
17 ~~the Secretary may enter into a memorandum of under-~~
18 ~~standing with the person that will acquire lands from the~~
19 ~~United States in the exchange, to establish such terms and~~
20 ~~conditions as are mutually agreeable regarding how those~~
21 ~~lands will be managed after the exchange.”.~~

22 (b) CHANGE IN ACREAGE CEILING.—Such section is
23 further amended by striking “one million two hundred and
24 thirty-six thousand eight hundred and eighty acres” and
25 inserting “1,256,000 acres”.
