A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study of the suitability and feasibility of establishing a Presidential National Historic Site, in Hope, Arkansas, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Presidential Historic
5 Site Study Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PRESIDENTIAL HISTORIC SITE STUDY.**

2 (a) STUDY AND REPORT.—Not later than 2 years
3 after the date funds are made available, the Secretary of
4 the Interior shall—

5 (1) carry out a study on the suitability and fea-
6 sibility of designating the William Jefferson Clinton
7 birthplace home located in Hope, Arkansas, as a na-
8 tional historic site; and

9 (2) submit to the Committee on Resources of
10 the House of Representatives and the Committee on
11 Energy and Natural Resources of the Senate a re-
12 port describing the findings, conclusions, and rec-
13 ommendations of the study.

14 (b) REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDY.—Except with re-
15 gard to deadline for completion provided in subsection (a),
16 the study under subsection (a) shall be conducted in ac-
17 cordance with section 8(c) Public Law 91–383 (16 U.S.C.
18 1a–5(c)).
