1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF RICHARD S. ARNOLD UNITED**
2 **STATES COURTHOUSE.**

3 The United States courthouse located at 600 West
4 Capitol Avenue in Little Rock, Arkansas, and any addition
5 to the courthouse that may hereafter be constructed, shall
6 be known and designated as the “Richard S. Arnold
7 United States Courthouse”.

8 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

9 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
10 paper, or other record of the United States to the United
11 States courthouse referred to in section 1 shall be deemed
12 to be a reference to the Richard S. Arnold United States
13 Courthouse.
