Mr. HANSEN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To make certain adjustments to the boundaries of the Mount Nebo Wilderness Area, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Mount Nebo Wilder-
5 ness Boundary Adjustment Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENTS.**

7 (a) LANDS REMOVED.—The boundary of the Mount
8 Nebo Wilderness is adjusted to exclude the following:

1 (1) MONUMENT SPRINGS.—The approximately
2 26.045 acres of land depicted on the Map as “Monu-
3 ment Springs”.

4 (2) GARDNER CANYON.—The approximately
5 202.084 acres of land depicted on the Map as
6 “Gardner Canyon”.

7 (3) BIRCH CREEK.—The approximately 4.161
8 acres of land depicted on the Map as “Birch Creek”.

9 (4) INGRAM CANYON.—The approximately
10 17.296 acres of land depicted on the Map as
11 “Ingram Canyon”.

12 (5) WILLOW CREEK SOUTH.—The approxi-
13 mately 68.156 acres of land depicted on the Map as
14 “Willow Creek South”.

15 (6) WILLOW CREEK NORTH.—The approxi-
16 mately 50.38 acres of land depicted on the Map as
17 “Willow Creek North”.

18 (7) MENDENHALL CANYON.—The approxi-
19 mately 16.350 acres of land depicted on the Map as
20 “Mendenhall Canyon”.

21 (8) WASH CANYON.—The approximately 44.302
22 acres of land depicted on the Map as “Wash Can-
23 yon”.

24 (b) LANDS ADDED.—Subject to valid existing rights,
25 the boundary of the Mount Nebo Wilderness is adjusted

1 to include the approximately 439.209 acres of land de-
2 picted on the Map for addition to the Mount Nebo Wilder-
3 ness. The Utah Wilderness Act of 1984 (Public Law 94-
4 428) shall apply to the land added to the Mount Nebo
5 Wilderness pursuant to this subsection.

6 **SEC. 3. MAP.**

7 (a) DEFINITION.—For the purpose of this Act, the
8 term “Map” shall mean the map entitled “Mt. Nebo Wil-
9 derness Boundary Adjustment”, numbered 1256, and
10 dated August 18, 2000.

11 (b) MAP ON FILE.—The Map shall be on file and
12 available for inspection in the office of the Chief of the
13 Forest Service, Department of Agriculture.

14 (c) CORRECTIONS.—The Secretary of Agriculture
15 may make technical corrections to the Map.

16 **SEC. 4. TECHNICAL BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT.**

17 The boundary of the Mount Nebo Wilderness is ad-
18 justed to exclude the approximately 21.26 acres of private
19 property located in Andrews Canyon, Utah, and depicted
20 on the Map as “Dale”.

21 **SEC. 5. ACCESS FOR MAINTENANCE OF ESTABLISHED**
22 **WATER SYSTEMS.**

23 Section 305 of the Utah Wilderness Act of 1984
24 (Public Law 98-428) is amended—

1 (1) by inserting “or systems” before “, or any
2 combination of the foregoing”; and

3 (2) by inserting “established water system oper-
4 ations,” before “and water reservoir operation pur-
5 poses.”.
