## A BILL

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 1199 Pasadena Boulevard in Pasadena, Texas, as the “Jim Fonteno Post Office Building”.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. JIM FONTENO POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4       (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
5       Postal Service located at 1199 Pasadena Boulevard in

1 Pasadena, Texas, shall be known and designated as the  
2 “Jim Fonteno Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
6 be deemed to be a reference to the Jim Fonteno Post Of-  
7 fice Building.
