## A BILL

To clarify that the Upper Missouri River Breaks National Monument does not include within its boundaries any privately owned property, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Upper Missouri River  
5 Breaks Boundary Clarification Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PRIVATELY OWNED PROPERTY EXCLUDED FROM**  
7 **MONUMENT.**

8 (a) BOUNDARY CLARIFICATION.—The Upper Mis-  
9 souri River Breaks National Monument, established by

1 Presidential proclamation 7398 on January 17, 2001,  
2 shall not include within its boundaries any privately owned  
3 property.

4 (b) MAP.—The Secretary shall keep a map of the  
5 Monument reflecting the boundary clarification in sub-  
6 section (a) on file and available for public inspection in  
7 the appropriate offices of the Director of the Bureau of  
8 Land Management, Department of the Interior.
