## A BILL

For the relief of Barbara Makuch.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PAYMENT.**

4 In consideration of the fact that Barbara Makuch—

5 (1) served 22 years as a foreign counterintel-  
6 ligence agent and dedicated her life to assist the  
7 Federal Bureau of Investigation in its efforts at the  
8 height of the Cold War to combat communism, the

1       Komitet Gosudarstvennoy Bezopasnosti (KGB), and  
2       the Soviet Union,

3           (2) was presented the Louis E. Peters Memo-  
4       rial Service Award, the highest civilian award pre-  
5       sented by the Federal Bureau of Investigation, for  
6       her valorous service, and

7           (3) has not received employment assistance or  
8       health, social security, or pension benefits, despite  
9       assurances that she would receive such benefits upon  
10      her retirement,

11      the Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, out of funds not  
12      otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,000,000 to Barbara  
13      Makuch of East Amherst, New York, in compensation for  
14      the lifetime aggregate value of benefits earned but not re-  
15      ceived by Barbara Makuch.

16      **SEC. 2. SATISFACTION OF CLAIM.**

17           The sum paid under section 1 shall be in full satisfac-  
18      tion of any claims that Barbara Makuch may have against  
19      the United States arising out of her service for the Federal  
20      Bureau of Investigation.

21      **SEC. 3. LIMITATION ON ATTORNEY FEES.**

22           Not more than 10 percent of the sum paid under sec-  
23      tion 1 shall be paid to or received by any agent or attorney  
24      for services rendered in connection with the recovery of

1 such sum. Any person who violates this section shall be  
2 fined under title 18, United States Code.
