## A BILL

To amend title 31, United States Code, to specify that the reverse of the 5-cent piece shall bear an image of Monticello, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Keep Monticello on  
5       the Nickel Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REVERSE OF THE NICKEL REQUIRED TO BEAR AN**  
2 **IMAGE OF MONTICELLO.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 5112(d)(1) of title 31,  
4 United States Code, is amended by inserting after the 4th  
5 sentence the following new sentence: “The reverse of the  
6 5-cent piece shall bear an image of Monticello.”.

7 (b) **CLARIFICATION ON AUTHORITY OF THE SEC-**  
8 **RETARY.**—No provision of section 5112(d)(2) of title 31,  
9 United States Code, may be construed as authorizing the  
10 Secretary of the Treasury to alter or change the design  
11 on the reverse of the 5-cent piece.
