



1           “(i) for fiscal year 2003 is equal to  
2           the DSH allotment for the State for fiscal  
3           year 2001 under the table in paragraph  
4           (2), without regard to paragraph (4), in-  
5           creased, subject to subparagraph (B) and  
6           paragraph (5), by the percentage change in  
7           the consumer price index for all urban con-  
8           sumers (all items; U.S. city average), for  
9           fiscal year 2001; and

10           “(ii) for each succeeding fiscal year is  
11           equal to the DSH allotment for the State  
12           for the previous fiscal year under this sub-  
13           paragraph increased, subject to subpara-  
14           graph (B) and paragraph (5), by 1.7 per-  
15           cent or, in the case of fiscal years begin-  
16           ning with the fiscal year specified in sub-  
17           paragraph (C) for that State, the percent-  
18           age change in the consumer price index for  
19           all urban consumers (all items; U.S. city  
20           average), for the previous fiscal year.”; and

21           (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-  
22           paragraph:

23           “(C) FISCAL YEAR SPECIFIED.—For pur-  
24           poses of subparagraph (A)(ii), the fiscal year  
25           specified in this subparagraph for a State is the

1 first fiscal year for which the Secretary esti-  
2 mates that the DSH allotment for that State  
3 will equal (or no longer exceed) the DSH allot-  
4 ment for that State under the law as in effect  
5 before the date of the enactment of this sub-  
6 paragraph.”.
