A BILL

To repeal the sunset of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001 with respect to qualified tuition programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF APPLICABILITY OF SUNSET OF THE**
4 **ECONOMIC GROWTH AND TAX RELIEF REC-**
5 **ONCILIATION ACT OF 2001 WITH RESPECT TO**
6 **QUALIFIED TUITION PROGRAMS.**

7 Section 901 of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief
8 Reconciliation Act of 2001 is amended by adding at the
9 end the following new subsection:

1 “(c) EXCEPTION.—Subsection (a) shall not apply to
2 the amendments made by section 402 (relating to modi-
3 fications to qualified tuition programs).”.
