A BILL

To adjust the boundaries of the Salt River Bay National Historical Park and Ecological Preserve located in St. Croix, Virgin Islands.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT.**

2 *The first sentence of section 103(b) of the Salt River*
3 *Bay National Historical Park and Ecological Preserve at*
4 *St. Croix, Virgin Islands, Act of 1992 (16 U.S.C. 410tt–*
5 *1(b)) is amended to read as follows: “The park shall consist*
6 *of approximately 1015 acres of lands, waters, and interests*
7 *in lands as generally depicted on the map entitled ‘Salt*
8 *River Bay National Historical Park and Ecological Pre-*
9 *serve, St. Croix, U.S.V.I.’, numbered 141/80002, and dated*
10 *May 2, 2002.”.*

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
