A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. RELEASE OF RETAINED RIGHTS, INTERESTS,**
2 **AND RESERVATIONS, FORMER O'REILLY GEN-**
3 **ERAL HOSPITAL, SPRINGFIELD, MISSOURI.**

4 (a) **RELEASE REQUIRED.**—Notwithstanding the first
5 section of the Act of August 9, 1955 (chapter 661; 69
6 Stat. 592), the Administrator of General Services shall re-
7 lease, without consideration, all right, title, and interest
8 retained by the United States in and to the portion of the
9 former O'Reilly General Hospital in Springfield, Missouri,
10 conveyed to the State of Missouri pursuant to such Act.

11 (b) **INSTRUMENT OF RELEASE.**—As soon as possible
12 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Adminis-
13 trator of General Services shall execute and file in the ap-
14 propriate office a deed of release, amended deed, or other
15 appropriate instrument effectuating the release of inter-
16 ests required by subsection (a).
