AN ACT

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction
of a hydroelectric project in the State of Oregon.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY**
2 **REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Notwithstanding the time period
4 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16
5 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal En-
6 ergy Regulatory Commission project number 11509, the
7 Commission shall, at the request of the licensee for the
8 project, and after reasonable notice, extend the time pe-
9 riod during which the licensee is required to commence
10 the construction of the project for 3 consecutive 2-year
11 periods.

12 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—Subsection (a) takes effect
13 on the date of the expiration of the extension issued by
14 the Commission under section 13 of the Federal Power
15 Act (16 U.S.C. 806) for Federal Energy Regulatory Com-
16 mission project number 11509.

17 (c) **REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED LICENSE.**—If the
18 period required for commencement of construction of the
19 project described in subsection (a) has expired prior to the
20 date of the enactment of this act, the commission shall
21 reinstate the license effective as of the date of its expira-

1 tion and the first extension authorized under subsection
2 (a) shall take effect on the date of such expiration
