## A BILL

To amend the Appalachian Regional Development Act of 1965 to designate Edmonson, Hart, and Metcalfe Counties, Kentucky, as part of the Appalachian region.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 403 of the Appalachian Regional Develop-  
4 ment Act of 1965 (40 U.S.C. App.) is amended in the  
5 third undesignated paragraph relating to Kentucky—

6 (1) by inserting “Edmonson,” before “Elliott,”;

7 (2) by inserting “Hart,” after “Harlan,”; and

8 (3) by inserting “Metcalfe,” after “Menifee,”.
