## A BILL

To reauthorize the Trade Adjustment Assistance program through fiscal year 2006, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REAUTHORIZATION OF TRADE ADJUSTMENT**

4 **ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.**

5 (a) ASSISTANCE FOR WORKERS.—Section 245 of the  
6 Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2317) is amended by strik-  
7 ing “the period beginning October 1, 1998, and ending  
8 September 30, 2001,” each place it appears and inserting  
9 “each of fiscal years 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, and  
10 2006”.

1 (b) ASSISTANCE FOR FIRMS.—Section 256(b) of the  
2 Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2346(b)) is amended by  
3 striking “for the period beginning October 1, 1998, and  
4 ending September 30, 2001” and inserting “for each of  
5 fiscal years 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, and 2006”.

6 (c) TERMINATION.—Section 285(c) of the Trade Act  
7 of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2771 note) is amended in paragraphs  
8 (1) and (2)(A) by striking “September 30, 2001” and in-  
9 serting “September 30, 2006”.

10 (d) TRAINING LIMITATION.—Section 250(d)(2) of  
11 the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2330(d)(2)) is amended  
12 by striking “for the period” and all that follows through  
13 “September 30, 2001.”

14 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FILING PETITIONS FOR**  
15 **WORKER ASSISTANCE.**

16 Section 223(b)(1) of the Trade Act of 1974 (19  
17 U.S.C. 2273(b)(1)) is amended by striking “one year” and  
18 inserting “two years”.
