AN ACTTo make technical amendments to section 10 of title 9,
United States Code.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. VACATION OF AWARDS.**

4 Section 10 of title 9, United States Code, is
5 amended—

6 (1) by indenting the margin of paragraphs (1)
7 through (4) of subsection (a) 2 ems;

8 (2) by striking “Where” in such paragraphs
9 and inserting “where”;

1 (3) by striking the period at the end of para-
2 graphs (1), (2), and (3) of subsection (a) and insert-
3 ing a semicolon and by adding “or” at the end of
4 paragraph (3);

5 (4) by redesignating subsection (b) as sub-
6 section (c); and

7 (5) in paragraph (5), by striking “Where an
8 award” and inserting “If an award”, by inserting a
9 comma after “expired”, and by redesignating the
10 paragraph as subsection (b).
